SwissText is a one-day conference on automatic text analytics, which takes place June 8, 2016 in Zurich. We invite practitioners, analysts, end users, software vendors, researchers and data scientists to join SwissText and share their expertise and experience with the audience.

SwissText will bring together practitioners and researchers, to give an overview of existing solutions and technologies, and to come up with ideas for new and innovative projects using automatic text understanding. Topics of interest include, but are not limited to:

The conference will see three types of presentations:

- **Surveys:** Distinguished experts are invited to present state-of-the-art technologies and solutions in one sub-field of text understanding. These presentations will give the audience sufficient information to find out if the field is relevant to their daily work. For this reason, surveys will not dive deep into single technologies, but rather give an overview of the entire field, current trends and solutions from “a bird eyes view”.
- **Showcases:** Many companies are using text analytics in their daily work, and various innovative products and services are already available. Showcase presentations will describe the most interesting and successful projects and applications.
- **Open Problem Presentations:** We invite experts from industry to present and discuss “their” open problem. Each presentation will see a short introduction of the problem, followed by a brief discussion with the audience about potential solutions and approaches. At the end, interested experts can join a subgroup to further discuss the problem - and maybe initiate a joint project.
